The International League of Peoples' Struggle (ILPS) Chapters in the Philippines and Hong Kong and Macau would like to invite you to participate in a conference entitled "*International Solidarity Conference to Resist US Imperialist Led War and Build Just Peace*" scheduled on the 10th November 2017. The solidarity conference will be held at Bahay Kalinaw, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City, Philippines and will be followed by series of events from November 11-13, 2017.

The November events are an opportune time to highlight and consolidate the people's global resistance against imperialist economic, political and military agenda as well as develop a plan of action as we intensify the campaign against imperialist agenda in Asia and the Pacific. During this period, member organizations of ILPS in Asia and the Pacific will hold a consultation meeting for regional campaign coordination and relaunch the Ban the Bases network.

The November meetings will coincide with the East Asian Summit happening in the Philippines on November 13-14. The series of meetings and events will be as follows:
